**Enrollment and Registration Policies:**

- All children must be registered in the Closter School System. They must be in Kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade.
- All **Kindergarten children must be picked up at the classroom door** upon dismissal from the ASEP class.
- Priority enrollment will be given to those families that have paid their 2011/2012 PTO dues.
- The following information must be presented at time of registration:
  - Completed registration form with check for the total of all classes. (One check per child)
  - Please make sure all emergency information is completed including dismissal procedures.
- **The registration deadline is FRIDAY, JANUARY 6th.**
- If there are more applicants than spots in the class, classes will be filled by a **random selection** of students whose application has been received by the deadline date. Any child closed out of a session will have first choice at the next session. If you were closed out of a previous session you still need to submit a registration form with payment.
- For some classes, priority will be given to specific grades based on the instructor's preference. (i.e. older or younger children)
- There are instances where classes are full or have to be cancelled. Please indicate a 2<sup>nd</sup> choice in case this occurs.

**Payment Fees and IMPORTANT ABSENTEE Policies:**

- The fee for each class is listed on the registration form and varies by class.
- Each class lasts for 1 hour (3:20pm to 4:20pm) and runs for 8 weeks.
- Please submit fee and completed registration form in an envelope labeled: ASEP – class name, student name, teacher and grade. (Only one form and envelope is necessary per child – if multiple days are selected, write the 1<sup>st</sup> class on envelope)
- Please write ONE check for each child. The check should be for the total amount if your child is taking more than one class. (Fill out one form per child).
- Make all checks payable to the Closter PTO. Please write ASEP in the memo area on the bottom of your check.
- Payment (cash or check) must accompany registration form.
- **If your child is taken out of school early or will not be staying for the after school program please send a note for your child's classroom teacher to put into the office in the After School Box. This will make the attendance procedure much easier. In addition, if you sign your child out early please write clearly in the book in the office. If you decide at the last minute to collect your child from school at regular dismissal time, kindly inform a member of the ASEP team by the main office of the school upon picking up your child.**

**Dismissal and Pick-up:**

- ASEP ends promptly at 4:20pm. It is mandatory that the parent/guardian pick up their child/children at that time.
- If you would like your child to walk to the **front of the school** at the end of the class please indicate that in the space provided on the registration form. Children must go to the **front of the building** and can't be picked up on the side/back loop. (**Kindergarten children must be picked up at the classroom**)
- Be sure to choose the dismissal preference carefully (Pick up at the classroom or dismissed on their own). **There will be no changes allowed.** Your cooperation in maintaining these dismissal arrangements for the duration of the session is greatly appreciated and reduces potential complications.
- If the parent/guardian is late in picking up the child/children by 10 minutes or more, a \$5 late pick-up fee will be collected for the first 10 minutes and \$1 for each additional minute of tardiness. If a parent/guardian is late in picking up his/her child two times the child will not be allowed to return to the program and NO refund will be given. If late fee payment is not made, the child will not be allowed to participate in future classes.
- Children enrolled in the SACC program will walk independently to the designated SACC location at the completion of the ASEP class. Please indicate on the form if your child will be going to SACC after the ASEP class ends.

**School Closing:**

- There will be no classes on scheduled holidays or days on which school has been closed as a result of inclement weather. There will be no make up classes.

**Refunds/Class Cancellation:**

- Refunds will only be given as a result of insufficient enrollment. If there are not enough students signed up, class will be cancelled and your check will be returned.
- Please have your child choose his/her classes carefully since, due to the extensive data inputting and timely distribution of attendee reports, we cannot offer refunds should your child decide to no longer continue in a class. No exceptions will be made.
- No refunds will be given due to student illness, student withdrawal for personal reasons, expulsion due to behavior problems or class cancellation due to inclement weather.

**Discipline Policy:**

- The ASEP Instructors have the responsibility of setting up a secure and warm learning environment for their students. However, continual disruption from a student(s) will inhibit their ability to deliver the lesson as planned. The ASEP team reserves the right to suspend, without refund, any child who presents a constant threat to themselves or others in the class. Parents will be notified of the problem and the situation. If the problem persists, the child will be dismissed from the program. No refund will be given. Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
