- Visit www.closterpto.org to access your account by entering **your email address** and a **unique password**
- NEW FAMILIES: visit www.closterpto.org and click “create your account” and follow the on-line instructions.

The Closter PTO offers an After School Enrichment Program (ASEP) at Hillside Elementary School in the Fall and Winter. Classes are held on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons, for 8 consecutive weeks (see FALL 2018 calendar below). ASEP is sponsored and administered by the Closter PTO. ENROLLMENT POLICIES:

- All children must be registered in the Closter School System and attend Hillside School (Grades K-4th).
- ASEP is only available to PTO Members (families who have paid their 2018/2019 PTO dues).
- **The registration deadline is FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 14TH.**
- For some classes, priority will be given to specific grades based on the instructor's preference. (e.g. older or younger children)
- There are instances where class enrollment is low and have to be cancelled. **Please indicate a 2nd choice.** If you choose NO SECOND CHOICE, you will get a full refund if that class is cancelled due to low enrollment and we won't be able to put your child into any other classes on that day.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT:

- The fee for each class varies by class - please refer to Class Overview, Online listing or Registration Packet.
- Each class lasts for 1 hour (3:20pm to 4:20pm) and runs for 8 weeks.
- **ONLINE REGISTRATION:** Please visit www.closterpto.org to complete your registration and payment online (as per instructions provided).
- **YOUR CHILDS PLACEMENT WILL NOT BE CONFIRMED UNTIL YOUR PAYMENT HAS BEEN PROCESSED.**

IMPORTANT ABSENTEE POLICIES:

- If your child is taken out of school early or will not be staying for ASEP, please send a note for your child's classroom teacher to be given to the main office. This will assist us when we take attendance at the start of the ASEP class. In addition, if you sign your child out early, please write clearly in the book in the office. If you decide at the last minute to collect your child from school at regular dismissal time, kindly inform the main office of the school upon picking up your child.

IMPORTANT DISMISSAL AND PICKUP INFORMATION:

- ASEP classes end promptly at **4:20pm**. It is mandatory that the parent/guardian pick up their child/children at that time. *If the parent/guardian is late in picking up the child/children by 10 minutes or more, a \$10 late pick-up fee will be collected for the first 10 minutes and \$1 for each additional minute of tardiness. If a parent/guardian is late in picking up his/her child two times during the ASEP session, the child will not be allowed to return to the program and NO refund will be given. If late fee payment is not made, the child will not be allowed to participate in future classes.*
- **KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS (and ONLY Kindergarten)** will be accompanied by the ASEP Instructor to the front lobby of Hillside School and will be handed over to the parent/caregiver at the front door. Kindergarten Parents are not permitted to enter the building. *Students who are not met by a pre-assigned adult will not be released for dismissal.*
- **ALL 1st thru 4th Grade STUDENTS** will be dismissed from their ASEP classes at 4:20pm and will leave the building from the main entrance (front of the building only). Parents are not permitted to enter the building.
- Please PARK your car in a valid parking space and walk to meet your child in the area outside the front doors. **DO NOT DOUBLE PARK IN THE FRONT LOOP - THIS IS EXTREMELY DANGEROUS FOR STUDENTS/PARENTS USING THE CROSS WALK**
- Students enrolled in the **SACC program** will walk independently to the designated SACC location at the completion of the ASEP class. (Kindergarten Students enrolled in SACC will be met at the ASEP classroom by a SACC representative and accompanied to the SACC location). Please indicate on the form if your child will be going to SACC after the ASEP class ends.

SCHOOL CLOSING:

- There will be no ASEP classes on scheduled holidays or days on which school has been closed as a result of inclement weather.
- There will be no make-up classes.

REFUNDS/CLASS CANCELLATION:

- Refunds will only be given as a result of insufficient enrollment. If there are not enough students signed up, class will be cancelled and your check will be returned if you don't choose a second choice.
- Please have your child choose his/her classes carefully. Once classes start, there will be NO refunds for cancellation due to any personal schedule change. And NO switching classes will be allowed.
No exceptions will be made and we appreciate your cooperation.
- No refunds will be given due to student illness, student withdrawal for personal reasons, and expulsion due to behavior problems or class cancellation due to inclement weather.

DISCIPLINE POLICY:

- The ASEP Instructors have the responsibility of setting up a secure and warm learning environment for their students. However, continual disruption from a student(s) will inhibit their ability to deliver the lesson as planned.
The ASEP team reserves the right to suspend, without refund, any child who presents a constant threat to themselves or others in the class. Parents will be notified of the problem and the situation. If the problem persists, the child will be dismissed from the program. No refund will be given. Disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.
